With a Master's in Guidance and Counseling, Rev. Heather Sigler is an ideal leader for studying the Book of Ruth.

A native of Central Pennsylvania—born in Harrisburg and raised in Camp Hill—Heather earned a BA in English and Secondary Education from Grove City College. During that time, she spent her junior year studying at the American University of Beirut, in Beirut Lebanon. She holds two Master's degrees: the aforementioned degree is in Educational Administration from Pennsylvania State University, and the second is a Master of Divinity from Pittsburgh Theological Seminary.

Her professional career includes service as a college administrator, high school English teacher and owner/coach of the Narragansett School of Gymnastics. When her family moved to western Pennsylvania in the late 1980's, Heather answered a lifelong call to ordained Ministry of Word and Sacrament in The Presbyterian Church (USA).

She served at Puckety Presbyterian Church in Lower Burrell and First Presbyterian Church, Sayre, before being called back to Central PA to become Associate for Congregational Service in the office of Carlisle Presbytery. Since retirement, Heather has served as Parish Associate at Pine Street Presbyterian Church.
